A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County Washington, confirming action taken by the District in the Execution of Public Works Construction Contract

WHEREAS, the District has issued a Notice of Award to Superior Asphalt Maintenance, Inc., the low bidding contractor for the District Small Works road failure project; and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners confirms by resolution its action taken in authorizing the General Manager to enter into contract with Superior Asphalt Maintenance, Inc. to carry out the terms and conditions of the contract for the lump sum bid amount of **\$23,235.20**, including state sales tax.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County, Washington as follows:

1. The action taken by the Board of Commissioners in authorizing the execution of the aforementioned Public Works Contract as set forth herein and as reflected in the minutes of the District's regular meeting, are hereby confirmed.

2. The District's General Manager is authorized to fully implement this agreement and to enforce the terms and conditions of the contract.







Notice is hereby given that Southwest Suburban Sewer District will receive bids for the repair of 2 road failures. The project is located in 2 different locations within the City of Burien & unincorporated King County. The bids for the above project will be received at the offices of Southwest Suburban Sewer District, 431 S.W. Ambaum Boulevard, Burien, Washington 98166, until 10:00 AM PST, May 4, 2016 at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read aloud.

The scope of this project is generally described as follows:

- Neat line cut all locations to be repaired
- Removal and disposal of existing asphalt, estimated to be 1" to 4" in depth
- Removal and disposal of a minimum of 4 feet of unsuitable subgrade material
- Compaction of existing subgrade
- Supply, Placement and Compaction of 1 ¼" minus crushed rock
- Placement of 2" to 4" of ½" HMA in 2" lifts or match existing
- Striping if necessary
- Traffic Control

Your lump sum price shall include all handling necessary for excavation, placement and compaction of the subgrade material. The lump sum price shall include excavation and disposal of unsuitable material to a minimum of 4 feet in depth, placement and compaction of imported 1 ¼" minus crushed rock and striping if necessary.

No bid bond will be required. Small Works Roster Registration is required if awarded.

Please remember, this is a municipal job and your proposal must also reflect prevailing wage.

Utility conflicts are present. A SPU water main runs north and south through the middle of the newer patch completed by SWSSD crews. The water utility was not marked on a previous locate request. A PSE gas service runs east and west through the road failure area.
