A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN SEWER DISTRICT, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, INCREASING THE DISTRICT'S MONTHLY STREET LIGHTING CHARGE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 57.08.060 and RCW 57.08.081 the Board of Commissioners of Southwest Suburban Sewer District ("District") is authorized to fix rates and charges for furnishing street lighting services as deemed necessary by the District Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the District staff and financial consultant have reviewed the current street lighting charge and recommended that the District's current street lighting charge be increased in order to cover previous rate increases adopted by Seattle City Light, and to provide for adequate reserves in the District's Street Light Fund; and

WHEREAS, after considering the recommendations of the District staff and the financial consultant, the District Board of Commissioners has determined that a rate increase for street lighting services is necessary and appropriate; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County, Washington, as follows:

- 1. Effective April 1st, 2013, the monthly charge for street lighting services shall be increased from \$2.00 to \$2.70 per month.
- 2. All District resolutions, policies and procedures are hereby amended to be in accordance with this Resolution.
