

RESOLUTION 2010-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN SEWER DISTRICT, KING
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, RATIFYING AND CONFIRMING
AS COMPLETED, THE CONTRACT COMMONLY KNOWN
AS THE CHELSEA PARK IV PROJECT, BETWEEN
SHORELINE CONSTRUCTION, AS CONTRACTOR,
AND SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN SEWER
DISTRICT, AS OWNER**

WHEREAS, the District entered into a contract known as the Chelsea Park Phase IV Project ("Contract") with Shoreline Construction, for the installation and repair of sewer infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the District has certified that the contractor has substantially completed the contract and recommend acceptance of the project as complete; and

WHEREAS, Southwest's Board of Commissioners accepted such contract as complete in its regular meeting held on November 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the District determined that there was a total amount paid to Shoreline Construction, of \$628,619.87 representing the original contract amount of \$596,194.50 and bid item additions and deletions previously authorized in the amount of \$5,355.62 which, including sales tax of \$57,147.26, totaled \$658,697.38; and of such sums \$628,619.87 was paid to Shoreline Construction, by the District; and

WHEREAS, it was determined that the Retainage in the amount of \$30,077.51 shall be released upon receiving the following information:

- a) Receipt of the releases from the Department of Labor and Industries and the tax commission, including receipt of the Department of Revenue certificate;
- b) Verification that no liens have been filed against this public work improvement for thirty (30) days from the date of completion of the contract work; and
- c) On completion of (a) and (b), then said bond may be released by the District on or after thirty (30) days from the date of completion of the contract work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County, Washington, as follows: Prior action accepting as complete the Contract commonly known as the Chelsea Park Phase IV Project on November 9, 2010, is ratified and confirmed. There is a retainage which is still due to be released to the contractor. The retainage shall be held and released to the contractor on or after thirty (30) days from the date of contract acceptance (November 9, 2010) as ratified by this resolution, provided that, prior to release of such retainage, the District receives no claims against said retainage from the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries. Employment Securities Department or the Department of Revenue, and that no liens have been filed against the retainage within 30 days from the completion of contract work, or that any such claims or liens have been satisfied by the contractor within such thirty (30) days period.


