NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County, Washington, as follows:

1. The General Manager is authorized and directed to transfer the sum of \$2,000,000.00 from the Construction Revolving Fund Account #11-555-3020 to the Construction Fund, Account #11-555-3010 for the purpose of funding the District's capital facilities and satisfying debt.
