RESOLUTION NO. 2020-10-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHWEST SUBURBAN SEWER DISTRICT, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF UPGRADES TO THE DISTRICT'S SECURITY AND COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS AT BOTH WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANTS DUE TO SPECIAL FACILITIES OR MARKET CONDITIONS AND/OR A SINGLE SOURCE OF SUPPLY.

WHEREAS, due to increased instances of trespassing and theft Southwest Suburban Sewer District ("District") has a need to purchase and install certain upgrades to its existing security and communications systems at both the Miller Creek and Salmon Creek Wastewater Treatment Plants which will improve security and increase the reliability of the District's FirstNet two way communication as well as allow Wi-Fi enabled calling throughout the plants ("Security Upgrades");

WHEREAS, the necessary Security Upgrades will use a system similar to what was recently installed at the District main office and the District desires that the systems be of a standard configuration and compatible with each other; and

WHEREAS, the District's acquisition of the Security Upgrades includes the following components or elements of work: equipment, hardware, materials, installation and associated training; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to acquire the Security Upgrades using two vendors/companies that have been utilized in prior installations of the District's security and communications systems in order to ensure consistency and compatibility between the Security Upgrades and the existing security and communication systems used by the District; and

WHEREAS, the District believes that it has the authority to waive the competitive bidding requirements under the "special facilities or market condition" and/or "single source of supply" exceptions found in RCW 39.04.280(1)(a)-(b); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Southwest Suburban Sewer District, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein in full by this reference.

Section 2. Pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1), the District waives the competitive bidding requirements in Chapter 39.04 RCW relating to the District's acquisition of the Security Upgrades, and the District may proceed to acquire the Security Upgrades from Johnson Controls and Blackpoint IT.

Section 3. The District's staff is hereby authorized to proceed with the purchase, acquisition and installation of the Security Upgrades pursuant to the written quotations provided by Johnson Controls and Blackpoint IT.
