Established in 1945, Southwest Suburban Sewer District is a Special Purpose District that provides sewer service and wastewater treatment for approximately 66,000 residents of Burien, Normandy Park, White Center and parts of Des Moines and SeaTac. The District maintains and operates two secondary wastewater treatment plants, eleven lift stations, approximately 300 miles of sewer collection lines and over 2,000 sewer manholes.

### **GENERAL NATURE & SCOPE OF WORK**

Under the direction of the Sewer Department & Inspection Services Supervisor, this Union represented position will perform a variety of semi-skilled to skilled work in the installation, maintenance and repair of the Districts' sewer system. Perform CCTV inspection of mainlines and laterals; utilize mainline and lateral cameras; operate the CCTV truck mounted, or laptop computer to record data related to pipe type, size, depth, cracks, roots and other related concerns; Clean and root cut sewer lines; remove debris with a Vactor vacuum truck or other equipment; replace pipe when necessary; dye and smoke test lines; install and maintain flow meters.
